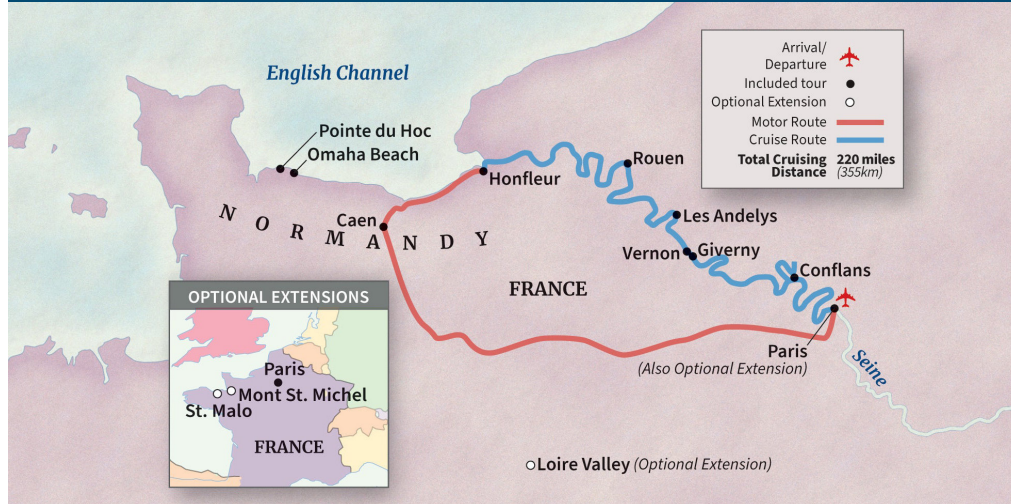

## WHAT TO EXPECT

### Group Size

- This trip has a group size of 35-42 travelers with our local Program Director exclusive to Grand Circle

### Pacing

- 12 days, with 10 nights aboard the M/S *Bizet*, and a 1 single-night hotel stay

### Physical Requirements

- Walk 3 miles unassisted and participate in 2-3 hours of physical activities each day, including stairs

- Not accessible for travelers using wheelchairs or scooters
- Travelers using walkers, crutches, or other mobility aids must travel with a companion who can assist them
- We reserve the right for Program Directors to restrict participation, or in some circumstances send travelers home, if their limitations impact the group's experience

### Terrain & Transportation

- Unpaved roads, hilly terrain, and uneven walking surfaces, including slippery cobblestones, stairs, and sand

- Travel by 120-passenger river ship, and 49-seat coach
- Changes in water-level depths may require adjustments to your itinerary

### Climate

- Daytime temperatures range from 50-80°F during cruising season
- July-August are the warmest months
- March and November weather can be unpredictable and change quickly

## YOUR ITINERARY

### DAY 1 • Depart U.S.

Depart today on your flight to Roissy, France.

### DAY 2 • Arrive Roissy, France

Arrive in Roissy. You'll be met at the airport and transferred to the hotel, along with individuals from our pre-trip extensions to *London, England*.

### DAY 3 • Roissy • Caen Peace Memorial Museum • Honfleur • Embark ship • Captain's Welcome Dinner

Transfer via motorcoach to the well-preserved port town of Honfleur, founded in the eleventh century. If you began your European explorations early with our pre-trip extension in *Brittany & Mont St. Michel, France*, you will join the main group today. En route, visit the Peace Memorial Museum in Caen, a state-of-the-art facility that presents the events of World War II, including D-Day.

Then, embark your ship, your private retreat for the next ten nights of your Seine River Cruise Tour. Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Drink followed by your Captain's Welcome Dinner.

### DAY 4 • Honfleur • Optional Cliffs of Etretat tour • French language lesson

Set off for a walking tour of Honfleur. Situated on a Seine estuary opposite Le Havre, the town was once one of the most important ports in France. It was from here that many voyages of discovery were launched, including the journey of native son Samuel de Champlain—who would go on to found Port Royal in Nova Scotia and the settlement of Quebec in Canada.

This afternoon, you may choose to join a half-day optional excursion to the beautiful cliffs on the Normandy coast at Etretat. First, you'll discover the White Bird Monument and then descend the cliffs to explore the sandy beaches. The ship remains in port tonight, where you can learn a few essential French phrases during an **Exclusive Discovery Series** language lesson.

### DAY 5 • Honfleur • Normandy beaches

Embark for a full-day tour of D-Day discoveries. First, visit the American Military Cemetery, where you'll see a monument honoring the fallen. Then, visit the cemetery of Colleville sur Mer, where 9,386 American soldiers were laid to rest.

Walk down to Omaha Beach for an up-close look at where the first Allied footing was achieved in German-occupied France. Continue delving into D-Day's unprecedented history as you make your way to Pointe du Hoc—a site all Normandy veterans know well—where Allied forces scaled 328-foot cliffs as they sought to silence German artillery.

### DAY 6 • Honfleur • Rouen

Depart Honfleur and cruise to Rouen. Take part in an onboard **Exclusive Discovery Series** conversation about Claude Monet, one of the Impressionist period's most iconic artists. Later, disembark for a walking tour of Rouen, the capital of Normandy. See the 14th-century abbey where Joan of Arc was sentenced to death, and visit the Market Square where her execution took place. After your tour, stop to savor something sweet during a tasting in a chocolate shop.

### DAY 7 • Rouen • Gourmet Tasting

Depart for an **Exclusive Discovery Series** Home-Hosted Visit in Rouen. You'll join a local family for a sweet treat, as well as an opportunity to learn



more about life in France. This afternoon is at your leisure, or join your Program Director on an elective walk where he or she will immerse you further into the culture of the region.

### DAY 8 • Rouen • Cooking demonstration • Les Andelys • Vernon

Enjoy a relaxing morning of river cruising. Partake in an onboard **Exclusive Discovery Series** event: Learn how to prepare a few of France's culinary delights as your ship's chef demonstrates cooking techniques. You'll also get the chance to savor a tasting of traditional French bread and cheese.

As you cruise toward Les Andelys, take in views of Chateau Gaillard while your Program Director leads a conversation about this imposing fortress from the era of Richard the Lionhearted. Later, enjoy an included walking tour of the village of Les Andelys.

### DAY 9 • Vernon • Giverny • Home-Hosted Visit

Disembark for an excursion into the countryside to see the lovely landscapes that inspired Claude Monet. Explore the artist's home and gardens, left by his son Michel to the Academie des Beaux-Arts in 1966 and now a museum dedicated to the great painter. The house is furnished as it was when the leader of the Impressionist School lived here, including his precious collection of Japanese engravings.

Stroll through the gardens, and spot the familiar Japanese bridge and water garden shaded by weeping willows, its pond still full of the water lilies that so permeated his work. Later, you'll embark on a discovery walk of Vernon.

**Please note:** The tour of Monet's home and gardens is not available on March or November departures. We will offer a walking tour of Vernon and a cider tasting in Giverny instead.

### DAY 10 • Vernon • Conflans • Optional Path of Van Gogh tour

Enjoy a leisurely morning of scenic cruising as we sail towards Conflans. Later, disembark for a walking tour in Conflans, followed by a free afternoon. Or, you may instead opt to join us on an optional *Path of Van Gogh* tour of Auvers-sur-Oise.

### DAY 11 • Conflans • Explore Paris

Spend the morning exploring Paris, being introduced to both the city's classic highlights and more intimate neighborhoods. First, enjoy a panoramic bus tour, witnessing the Eiffel Tower, among other iconic sights, from different perspectives. Then, disembark your bus and get a sense of daily life in Paris during a walking tour of one of the city's residential neighborhoods.

### DAY 12 • Paris • Montmartre • Captain's Farewell Dinner

Explore Montmartre, one of the most famous and lively of the city's

20 *arrondissements* (districts). We'll drive along the famed Champs-Élysées, and witness the Arc de Triomphe (commissioned by Napoleon in 1806 and completed in 1836), which stands at the end of the Champs-Élysées at a large central roundabout where twelve elegant, tree-lined avenues converge. Connecting all these iconic landmarks are the banks of the Seine River—Paris's only UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Enjoy a walking tour of Montmartre before spending some free time strolling the charming streets of this romantic neighborhood. Witness the famed Sacre Coeur Basilica, with its dramatic perch on the top of the Montmartre hill.
